

TUTORING APPLICATION

PURPOSE

The Community Education Center of Elk and Cameron Counties (CEC) offers tutoring services to students of all grade levels and subject areas including:

Based on demand, the CEC will accept applications for qualified tutors. Approved applicants will be placed on a list of potential tutors which will be used by the CEC to respond to requests. Tutoring will take place at the CEC's St. Marys or Emporium locations. The CEC will assist in scheduling appointments. Tutoring appointments are not guaranteed by completing this application or by becoming an approved tutor.

APPROVAL PROCESS

The CEC, in conjunction with education experts, will review the applications and application materials and select qualified candidates.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Professionals: Must have a degree or relevant training and/or at least 3 years of professional work experience in a related field
- College Students: Must be actively enrolled in college with an overall GPA of at least 3.0 and have received an "A" in a related course
- High School Students: Must maintain an "A" in the related field of study

RATES

The CEC will establish the fee schedule, collect fees from customers, and pay the tutors following the appointments. Payment rates are as follows:

- Professionals: \$20.00/hour
- College Students: \$12.00/hour
- High School Students: \$8.00/hour
